***Good News Club*® Guidelines CEF® of Central Indiana**

- Use *Child Evangelism Fellowship* curriculum. Required teaching components are the Bible lesson and Scripture memory. Some weeks the Gospel Spotlight is also required.
- All volunteers must complete the *CEF* Child Protection Policy which includes the *CEF* Statement of Faith and Doctrinal Protection Policy and receive approval before serving.
- Volunteers will complete *CEF* training based on current guidelines.
- Give a clear Gospel presentation every week, with invitation. Then counsel according to the need, including for salvation.
- Minimum of 4 screened and approved workers present at the club each week (2 adults with children at any given time). The goal is no more than an 8:1 ratio in small groups.
- Club must meet a minimum of 6 times during the school year.
- *CEF* staff will attend 1-2 weeks of new clubs. *CEF* staff will teach the Bible lesson the first club and assist with counseling. *CEF* staff will visit all clubs periodically.
- Submit a *CEF* statistical report monthly to the local *CEF* office.
